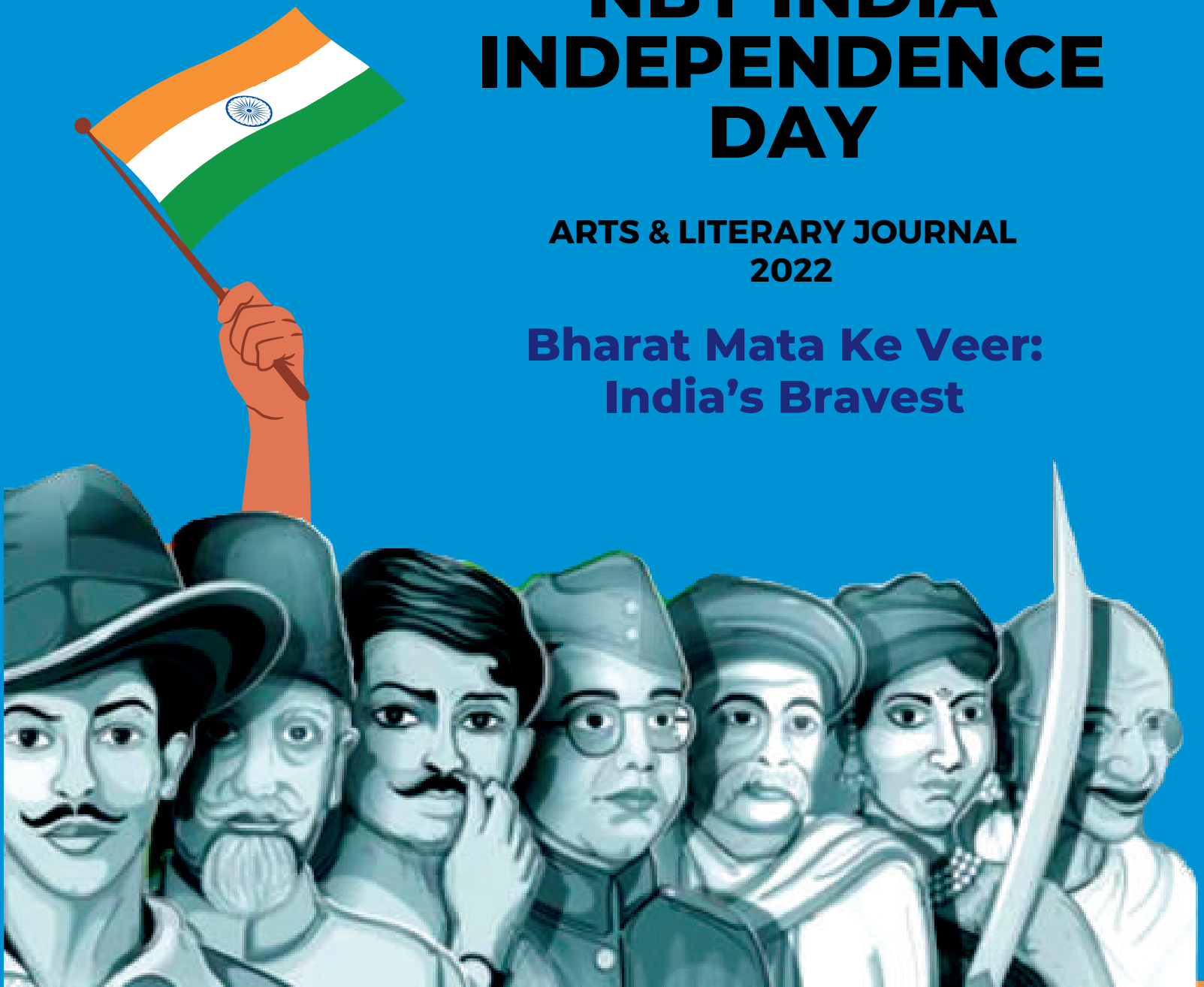

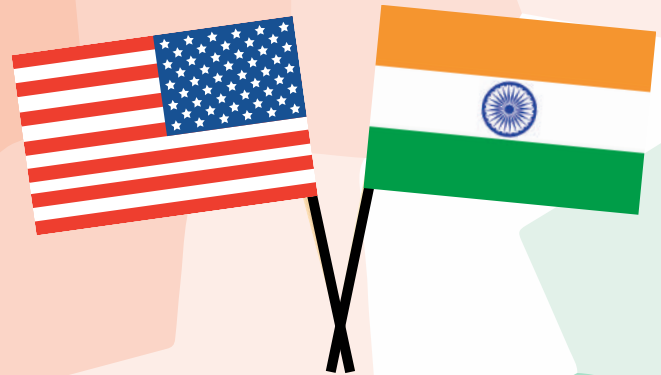


- WHEREAS**, The year 2022 marks the Seventy-Fifth Anniversary of India's Independence; and,



WHEREAS, India's Independence Day is celebrated by 1.3 billion people across the country with flag-hosting ceremonies, kite-flying, and parades; and



as he describes his country.

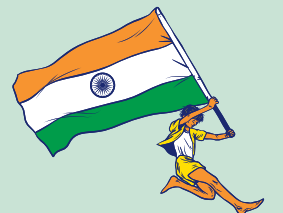

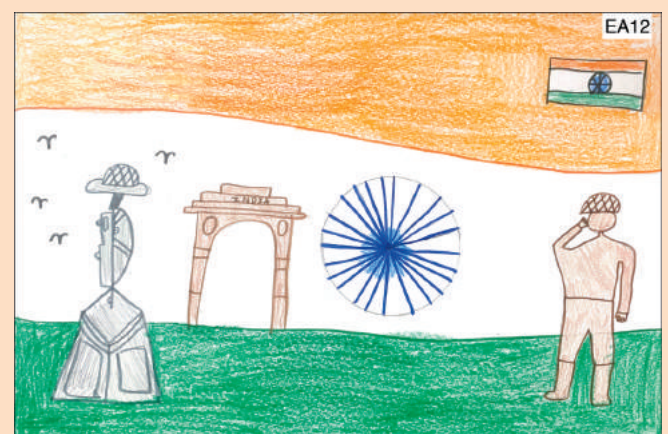
Have you ever wondered who saved our loved india? It was not one person but many who took those steps to save India.

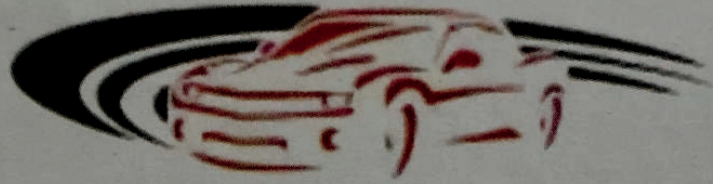

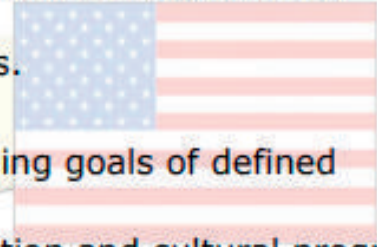
